Whole Loddon Love generates funds for flood recovery

The Whole Loddon Love live music events, held in communities across Loddon Shire, have raised almost \$5,000 for local groups.

Boort District School was just one of the recipients to benefit from the October music events across Loddon one year on from the 2022 flood.

Held in October, Whole Loddon Love saw a star-studded line up perform superb music in Pyramid Hill, Boort, Newbridge and Bridgewater-on-Loddon.

Performers who rocked Loddon included Jess Parker, Queenie, Dan Kelly, Valley Road and The Maes.

Loddon Shire Council thanked the organisers and musicians behind Whole Loddon Love for their support. Council really appreciates the amazing support in not only raising

these funds, but lifting the spirits of our communities by providing these performances.

Thanks to everyone involved in putting on some great music in Loddon, including the performers for generously providing their



time for these events. Local businesses helped support the project, including donations from Castlemaine's Shedshaker Brewing Company to participating venues – of which sales at each event generated almost \$3,000. Lake Meran Brewery also kicked in with discounted sales for the Boort performance.

Advanced ticket sales, raffle tickets, donations and door sales all contributed to fundraising efforts.

Whole Loddon Love was supported by Music Victoria and by the Victorian Government through Creative Victoria, with additional support from Loddon Shire Council.

Korong Vale Community Flood Study Discussion and Dinner

On Wednesday evening 29 November, 48 people gathered at Scully's Korong Vale Hotel for a free community dinner and to hear the outcomes of a study into options for reducing future flooding in the town.

Thirteen months on from the October 2022 flood event, the community was clearly glad for the opportunity to come together and reconnect after a long year of recovery.

Ashley Chen, a consultant with WMS Engineering, discussed the recently completed flood study report. Ashley presented four potential mitigation options, including three different drainage options along with the cost and benefits of raising flood prone dwellings in the town. Robust discussion followed with attendees putting forward additional practical solutions to be followed up as part of the study.

In attendance, and representing Loddon Shire Council, were Mayor Cr Gavan Holt, Boort Ward Councillor Neil Beattie and David Southcombe, Manager Assets and Infrastructure.

Representatives from the Australian Red Cross were also present to share resources developed to help prepare people for a future emergency and to further support the community.

Scully's Hotel provided a terrific meal and locals went away armed with valuable information, resources and options to consider.

Loddon Shire Council received funds from the Australian and Victorian governments under the National Partnership Agreement for Disaster Risk Reduction to undertake the Korong Vale Flood Study.

North Central Catchment Management Authority managed the project and engaged WMS Engineering to undertake a detailed flood study for the Korong Vale township.

The project involved hydrologic and hydraulic modelling of the study area, flood mapping for the full range of design flood events, and an assessment of potential mitigation options for the township.
