2018—2019 Calendar of Events

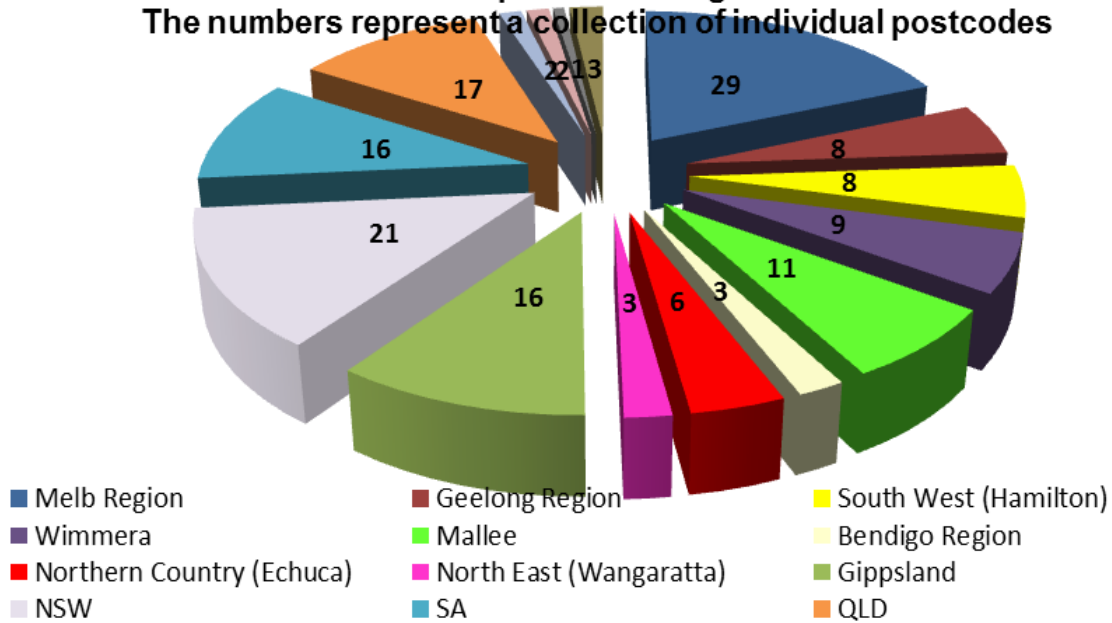
