<u>Saluté Oliva</u> was awarded the gold medal and champion trophy for Table Olives – Dried Olives at the Australian International Olive Awards. The company also won three silver medals for its 2018 season extra virgin olive oil, the Kalamata olives and mixed olives, and a bronze medal for its green olives.

Saluté Oliva's award-winning semi-dried olives were also featured on the menu at the Australian Olive Association's Annual Media Luncheon on 31 October.

Held at Restaurant Pendolino in Sydney, the event promotes Australian olive products and the industry to Australia's food media. It was also an opportunity for winners from the Australian International Olive Awards (including Saluté Oliva) to discuss their gold-medal-winning olives with the food media.

Our sincere thanks to all who organised and facilitated our stay in the Loddon Shire.


