Loddon ambassadors celebrated

Loddon Shire's volunteer ambassadors have been celebrated at a special event at the Wedderburn Community Centre on 15 June. Forty-two volunteers currently help staff the Loddon Visitor Information Centre, Wedderburn Community House (on a weekly basis), as well as Wedderburn Patchwork Group (three days per year).

The volunteers play an important role in helping promote the Loddon region. These ambassadors are crucial in providing visitors with information about our Shire and Loddon Valley region overall. The volunteers continue to provide a

valuable service in promoting our region and boosting the Loddon Valley profile across our state, nation and even internationally.

The Loddon ambassadors are a great example of the importance of volunteering in the Shire. Volunteers play a huge role in the Shire, whether it's volunteering at the Loddon Visitor Information Centre, the local sporting club, a not-for-profit group or looking after someone in the community.

The volunteer ambassador program is a partnership between the Loddon Visitor Information Centre, local businesses and the wider Loddon community.

The Loddon Visitor Information Centre is open seven days a week. Rostered hours for volunteers are Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm and Sunday and public holidays from 10am to 4pm (rostered for three-hour shifts). The information centre is closed on Christmas Day, Good Friday and Anzac Day.

Volunteers take part in familiarisation tours of the Loddon region twice per year, in autumn and spring. A Christmas dinner and other events for the volunteers are also held regularly.

The Opera was presented by GBD Productions, and hosted by Rachel Buckley. Sincere thanks to Rachel for bring such amazing talent to Tarnagulla.


