Bendigo NEXT Conference

On Monday 18 February the City of Greater Bendigo and Bendigo Tourism hosted their first Bendigo NEXT Conference. This was a tourism conference for industry leaders and the Loddon Shire Council were lucky have five representatives from the area attend. The day consisted of presentations from Visit Victoria, TripAdvisor, The Urban List, Author Simon Waller and Qantas. There were also three workshops by Melbourne Museum, I Heart Bargains and Great Ocean Stays.

It was extremely informative with some exciting news for tourism in the area. Some key notes were:

- Qantas flights from Bendigo to Sydney are due to commence 31 March and bookings have been made all the way through to Christmas
- Bendigo has had an increase in day visits by 75% which also helps neighbouring regions such as the Loddon Valley benefit from extra tourists travelling throughout the area.

Enjoy the Food and Wine Expo showcasing Loddon produce on Saturday 16 March at the Newbridge Recreation Reserve.

The highlight of the Loddon Valley Food and Wine Expo, the River Feast offers a three-course lunch prepared by chef Karen Martini (Better Homes and Gardens) and served grazing platter-style, matched with local wines, as diners overlook the expo in full swing against the background of the picturesque Loddon River.

Afterwards, take a wander around stalls showcasing the region's gourmet food and wine, all to a soundtrack of live music and entertainment.

Luncheon tickets include entry into the event, a three course lunch with grazing platters, all wines and a keepsake wine glass.

Live entertainment and food and wine tastings will be available in the outside area.

These awards recognise, highlight and celebrate what's great about our towns while acknowledging the hard work going into making our areas special.


Last year's award categories included environmental sustainability, protection of the environment, litter prevention, active schools, resource recovery and waste management, young leaders and community actions and leadership.
